- The school will follow the EBB Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBOU/Respective State/JCT/CRC, from time to time.
 - The School is required to apply an online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, 2008.
 - The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per Schedule 10 issued by District Education Officer (DEO), Headmaster's office.
 - The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructures, resources, physical education, and development and other concerned areas.
 - The school should go through the process of Affiliation and Examination Bye-Laws and frame its usage thereof for reference purpose and also attached to its CBOU application i.e., <http://cbou.nic.in> & <http://cbouonline.org> for update. The School is expected to use all syllabus provided by CBSE regularly.
 - The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire Sprinkler and Thermometers, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for pupils drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that fire, building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
 - Reference to this school:** is to be treated as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-Laws and rule 3.4.3, 3.4.5, P.1, P.2, B.4.2, B.4.3 & other relevant rules of Affiliation Bye-Laws.
 - The school is required to follow rules 3.4.2.1 and 3.4.3 of Affiliation Bye-Laws regarding Status and Quality of Education.
 - The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increased in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 3.4.7 of Affiliation Bye-Laws.
 - The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/identity/brand or any other identity related to running of school pursuant to CBOU. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of such consequences.
 - The school must strive to promote participation of environment in their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic, mobile, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, growing of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on environment protection and conservation, etc.
 - The school shall submit three information through Online Affiliated Schools Information System (OASIS) as per details given in circular no. OASIS-Affili-06/2014 dated 24.04.2014, for CBOU in available on Board's website <http://cbouonline.org>.
 - The stipulated teacher:teacher ratio of 1:10 as well as student:teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board.
 - Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly to novices and eligible students in Boards Class X and Class XII examinations from the year mentioned while granting affiliation up-gradation regularly without break or lorms with respect thereto in writing and in form about the non-participation of the candidates.
 - Running of coaching institutions by the school prior to the process of providing teaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Board action would be taken on offenders.
 - The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the administrative documents submitted/received by the School to the Board.
 - Apart from rules to be adhered to by the school as mentioned above for deriving specific attention of the relevant authorities, the school authorities are requested to assess the information with all the rules contained in Affiliation & Examination Bye-Laws and guidelines/guidelines/parameters issued by the Board from time to time, any law in following manner/conditions of the Board will not be valid.

18. The genuineness of information / documents / data submitted shall be of school and in case, if found otherwise the school shall invite action as per affiliation Bye laws-2018.
19. The school shall be responsible for submission of any pending compliance, reply of show cause /legal notice/ complaint and for submission of data/information sought by the Board. The extension of 05 years shall be from the date of cessation of previous validity of extension of affiliation.
20. The school is required to remit pending fee, if any.
21. The extension of affiliation is being granted as one time measure. However, the cases where the Show Cause Notice was communicated or grievance / legal cases are pending against the school, the Board will take appropriate decision in this matter.
22. The school shall renew all mandatory safety certificate i.e. Safe Drinking Water & Health and Hygiene certificate, Fire Safety Certificate and Building Safety Certificate from concerned Govt. authorities time to time.
23. The school shall also maintain record of certificate, compliances, data and other records/information and shall be fully responsible to produce all such records before Board and appropriate Government Authorities when asked for, failing which necessary action shall be taken as per AFFILIATION-Bye-Laws of the Board. The school shall also be liable for action by the appropriate Govt., in case of violation / non-compliance of the concerned Govt. norms.
24. The Board reserves the right to conduct inspection of school as per clause 11.2 and 11.4 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
